The California Cake Club is a non-profit organization working to promote the many facets of the confectionary arts in California. The Club was formed in December 1980 in Anaheim, California by Frances Kuyper.

CAKE CAMP

Our Club hosts a "Cake Camp" every two years. This is usually held during the summer at various locations, either in California, or a nearby state. Hands-on classes and demonstrations are conducted for all levels of expertise. These encompass a variety of subjects within cake decorating and the confectionary arts including: candy making, gumpaste, fondant, cookie design, airbrushing, royal icing, basic cake decorating, wedding cakes, business ideas, etc. Instructors for the camp are from all over the country and around the world! "BATTER CHATTER" NEWSLETTER

The "Batter Chatter" newsletter is published six times a year by the 3C's Newsletter Editor. It contains information on classes, cake shows, member news, recipes, baking tips, and cake patterns. There is always a President's Message, and the official minutes from the prior meeting. All members are encouraged to share information with the Editor to help support the newsletter.

MEETINGS

Our meetings are held four times a year in various cities. They are sometimes held in conjunction with local cake shows. We move the meetings around the state so members have a chance to attend a meeting that is close to them. At each of the meetings, we bring in demonstrators with varied knowledge in the field of cake decorating and sugar arts to share their knowledge. We also have board meetings and conduct Club business during these meetings. Come join the fun and learn new skills and techniques.

SCHOLARSHIPS

We award scholarships to current 3C's members during our meetings. We have an "Edith Gates Scholarship," a "Frances Kuyper Education Award," and various \$50 scholarships that are drawn at each meeting. Each scholarship can be used to attend a confectionary class, workshop, demonstration, or pay fees to attend Cake Camp, the Cake Cruise, or other confectionary meeting or event. Associate members are not eligible for scholarships.
